The Dutch Women's Council (<u>Dutch</u>: Nederlandse Vrouwen Raad (NVR)) was founded in 1898 as an <u>umbrella organization</u> to unite women's groups across the country in their struggles for women's equality. Poverty and financial dependency are risk factors for domestic violence and diminish the possibility to escape from it. Empowerment, financial independency and equal pay are important goals of the counsil.

Priority theme: Accelerating the achievement of gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls by addressing poverty and strengthening institutions and financing with a gender perspective.
